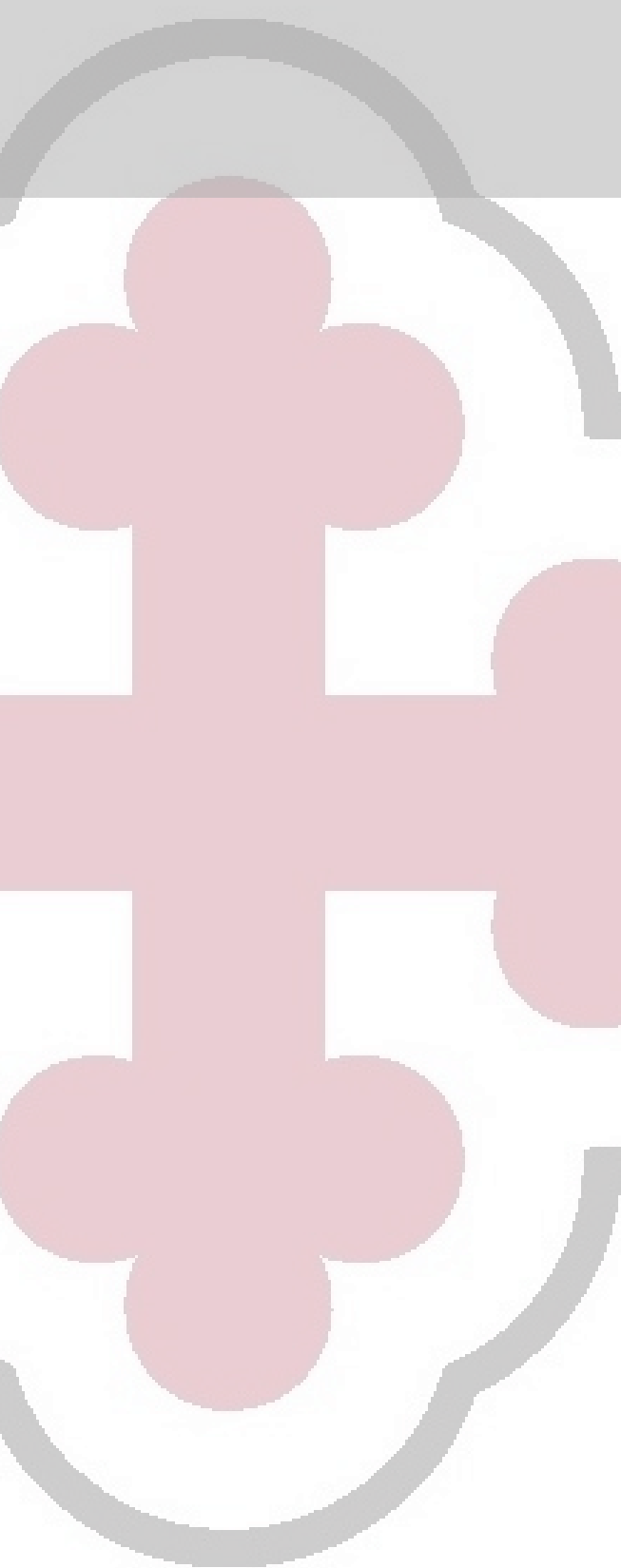




ANNUAL REPORT

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Letter from President and Executive Director

May 2025

Dear Members and Beneficiaries of the Corporation, greetings from the Board of Managers and Staff.

It is our pleasure to report that The Corporation continues to be in fine financial health; as of 12/31/2024, our assets were \$43.87 million, with a three-year trailing average of \$39.4 million. There are currently 422 members paid in full and 146 are dues paying members for a total of 568. Based on our audit, our current assets are sufficient to cover future obligations.

In 2024 \$1,013,959 was paid to Members and Beneficiaries under the following categories: we offered 18 Death Benefits (including six to Members) totaling \$179,450. Because of our sound management of assets over the years, we sent annual payments totaling \$263,064 to 125 Beneficiaries. We were also able to offer financial gifts to 25 Beneficiaries in the amount of \$571,445. The requests ranged from medical expenses to budgeting help to assisted living and beyond.

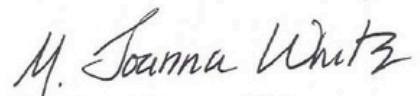
