Letter from President and Executive Director

May 2026

Dear Members and Beneficiaries of the Corporation, greetings from the Board of Managers and Staff.

It is our pleasure to report that The Corporation continues to be in fine financial health; as of 12/31/2025, our assets were \$50.1 million, with a three-year trailing average of \$44.43 million. There are currently 426 members paid in full and 168 are dues-paying members for a total of 594. Based on our audit, our current assets are sufficient to cover future obligations.

In 2025 \$949,623 was paid to Members and Beneficiaries under the following categories: 15 Death Benefits (including two to Members) totaling \$150,000; annual payments to 131 Beneficiaries totaling \$294,378; and financial gifts to 20 Beneficiaries in the amount of \$505,245. Over 50% of that money was to cover shortfalls in income. Other categories of support were medical (including dental, therapy, and homecare), home (including house repair, moving expenses, furniture, and housecleaning), family support (helping financially support children and grandchildren), and "other" (such as tax payments, social workers, and legal fees).

Of the \$1,244,080 spent in 2025, **81.5% was spent on program services** (including all the chaplain's compensation and a portion of the executive director's).

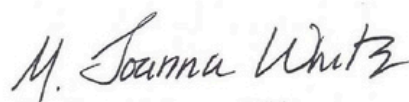
